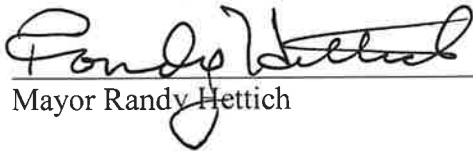

NEW BUSINESS

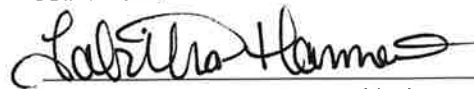
